- We provide fantastic content for parent communications & termly school assemblies.


- We make films that are seen by the public and are 100% made by 8-11 year olds including the composition and recording of soundtracks and foley design.

CINÉ CREATE

Film Academies run as an after school activity for up to 15 students from Year 3 - Year 6. Our Academies are run by 2 members of staff from Ciné Schools.

Our staff have DBS Enhanced certificates on the Update Service. They are Safeguarding Level 1 and PREVENT Trained. At least one member of staff has a current Paediatric First Aid qualification.

Our Autumn Term will see your school making a campaign film for a charity, they'll engage with the charity over zoom and make a 2 minute film for the organisation.

Our Spring Term sees your Film Academy making a documentary about a person of local interest, alumnae or a celebrity and finally our Summer Term sees us deep dive into the world of Silent Cinema with Chaplin and Keaton.

We run Film Studios all over London on school sites. We run various themes from Music Videos at Christmas, Advertising, Mixed Media Animation, Film Noir, Musicals, Science Fiction, Super Hero Studios and Halloween Horror Workshops.

We really stress FUN on these Studios and work with some amazing specialists from the world of animation, makeup, dance, music, stage fighting and stunts.

All of our Studios are fully risk assessed and insured. Our Studios have a capacity for 20 KS2 aged students with 3 members of staff on site at all times.

All of our Studios and Academies require contributor releases to be signed by parents before we proceed with productions so we can show their films online and at screening events.



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The Film Fund allows us to offer children from low income families the opportunity to take part in filmmaking.

30% of our students are provided for through funding from our enrichment partner PHASE Worldwide. It also allows us to establish fully funded Studios and Academies in deprived areas.

We also fund our own masterclasses at Film Festivals to help promote filmmaking at primary schools all over the country. It's our intention to be in every UK primary school by 2030.

This also covers our national accreditation programme which will give students the opportunity to gain qualifications across 3 grades (for free) whilst engaging in Studios and/or Academies.

We have Oscar and BAFTA award winning ambassadors supporting us #filmforall.

CURRICULUM FILMMAKING

Wherever we are, we've supported learning within the school curriculum. We've worked with The Natural History Museum to bring learning into schools, we've filmed lessons for the pandemic, we've created news channels and filmed trailers for students to summarise their learning. Ciné Schools has been and will continue to be an essential tool for supporting the advancement of learning across KS2 subjects.

Schools book a minimum of 3 units of 1x hour long sessions including editing for up to 30 students per unit. We offer two members of staff to consult with teachers as to how best to incorporate a filmed project for their class.

We come into the school with our kit, run the session and have the completed production ready for the following day. This could be walking through Narnia, a news report on Mount Vesuvius, exploring tombs in Egypt or creating an online lesson for absent children. There are no limits to the benefits of using filmmaking for learning.
